## Details of West Sussex's waste facility to be revealed at public exhibitions

A series of public exhibitions are to be held to outline details of a planning application for a state of the art waste treatment facility in West Sussex.

In September 2008, Biffa was appointed as West Sussex County Council's Preferred Bidder for the treatment of its non-recycled household waste at the Brookhurst Wood Landfill site. The company already has planning consent for a commercial Mechanical/Biological Treatment (MBT) facility to treat waste at this site. Following Biffa's appointment as WSCC's Preferred Bidder for the Materials Resource Management Contract, Biffa will be applying to amend the current permission to reflect the solution for West Sussex County Council.

The company's planning application will account for minor amendments to its plans relating to the layout and design of the facility and its capacity. This will ensure the facility meets the County's bespoke waste management demands for the next 25 years.

Biffa is undertaking a full programme of community engagement to inform local people about the plans and enable them to give their feedback.

The public exhibitions will be held on,

- Friday 27 February from 12pm to 8pm at Roffey Millennium Hall
- Saturday 28 February from 11am to 4pm at Warnham Village Hall
- Sunday 1 March from 11am to 2pm at Warnham Village Hall
